<p>Competition mode</p>	<p>Competition will be carried out according to the rules and sporting codes of the IJF – EJU KO system with double repechage; Preliminaries – 3 mats (8m x 8m) Bronze medals fights – 2 mats (8m x 8m) Finals – 1 mat (8m x 8m)</p>
<p>Technical meeting & Draw</p>	<p>No entries by names /changes/ can be done after the official draw on Friday 19 May 21.00 – Hotel Harnaś COS Szczyrk Plazowa 8.If your team arrives in Szczyrk late on that night all changes must be sent on the day by fax till 16.00 hour</p>

Participation limit	<p>Only entries of National Judo Federations will be accepted. Only 2 competitors from one country per weight category. Poland – max. 8 competitors per weight category. Officials number in a team is unlimited</p>
Referees	<p>All participating National Federations must be accompanied by one A or B or national referee which is one condition to participate in this tournament to meet the requirements of EJU rules for A category tournaments to secure neutral refereeing.</p>
Referee meeting	<p>Saturday 20 May : 9.15 Sport Hall COS</p>
Stay expenses	<p>Travel expenses are charge of participating countries. Stay expenses of the countries with a special invitations are the charge of the PJA (accommodation and meals for the number of persons indicated in the letter of invitations); all costs of additional participants will be born by your federation. Stay expenses of other federations must be done cash in Szczyrk.</p>
Financial condition	<p>40 EUR per person per night with full board – during tournament 19 – 21 May 35 EUR per person per night with full board – during training camp 22-24 May</p>
Accreditation fee	<p>For competitors not accommodated in the official hotel each competitor 50 EUR fee For competitors not accommodated in the official hotel during training camp 50 EUR each sportsmen</p>
Transfer	<p>Kraków/ Katowice/ Bielsko Biała (airport or railway station) to hotels in Szczyrk- and back are free of charge.</p>
Liability	<p>Neither the organizers of the event nor the Polish Judo Assotiation (or any of its officials or members) will be liable or responsible for any personal injury nor for any loss or damage to any property arising out of participations and traveling in connection with these championships.</p>
Entries	<p>1.All preliminary entries must reach Polish Judo Assotiation before 11 of April stating persons number and decision about accommodation /hotel/ to be booked for the team. All hotel reservation must be done only via Polish Judo Assotiation. 2. They must be sent to Polish Judo Assotiation till 09 May latest.</p>
